

# 2017 AP EXAMS

The 2017 Advanced Placement exams will be administered at CFHS from **Monday, May 1- Friday, May 12.**

Students and parents should please read the information in the *Bulletin for AP Students and Parents* and to talk with their AP teacher(s) as they decide whether or not to take AP exams in the spring.

- Students approved for testing accommodations should come to counseling in order to confirm their accommodations with Ms. Petrillo. Students not yet approved for accommodations should see their case manager or Ms. Petrillo as soon as possible to start the accommodation request process (*request deadline is February 10*).
- Students eligible for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program may qualify for a fee reduction. See the CFHS Bursar for more information or to double check your eligibility prior to registration.

**NEW THIS YEAR:** All students will be **required** to register ONLINE at **[www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/030476](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/030476)**. Once the online portion of the registration is complete, students will take their confirmation page and payment to the CFHS Bursar's Office by the end of the next business day. Checks should be made out to CFHS. Please check your confirmation page to make sure you have registered for the correct exam!

## **AP Exam Registration Information**

- **January 9, 2017 —Registration opens**
- **February 28, 2017—Registration closes**
- **Exam fee-- \$93 per exam** (AP Seminar exams have an additional \$48 premium, bringing total exam cost to \$141)
- **Alternate/Late exams** (extenuating circumstances only)—**please see Ms. Petrillo in the Counseling Office**

**Refund policy:** *Students may cancel their registration prior to the test date and receive a partial refund. Students who cancel a test ON or BEFORE March 6 will be refunded the full test amount MINUS a \$15.00 administrative fee. Students who cancel a test AFTER March 6 will be refunded the full test amount MINUS \$30.00 (\$15.00 administrative fee and \$15.00 College Board unused test fee). Students must see Ms. Petrillo in the Counseling Office to request to cancel a test.*

### Additional Quick Facts

- **Report times:** 7:30 am for morning exams, 12:00 pm for afternoon exams.
- Students **must report on time** to their assigned testing rooms. Assigned testing rooms will be posted in all AP classrooms. Students who arrive late may be denied entrance to the testing room.
- **Students are responsible** for knowing which materials to bring to each exam—see the Bulletin or visit the College Board’s website for details.
- Absences accrued due to AP exams will be verified as a **school-sponsored activity** and will not count against the absence total for the semester. Students will be excused only for the window of time they tested, not the entire day.
