- **Congratulations to the Boys and Girls Cross Country teams** who competed in the Desert Twilight Invitational in Casa Grande on Friday September 29th. This invitational is an elite event with over 220 schools from 10 different states. Senior Richelle Sandin placed 5th overall in the Premier Race, running a personal best time of 17:46, which equals a 5:43 per mile pace. The girl's varsity placed 15th out of 27 teams in the Premier Race. The boy's varsity team took 3rd Place out of 32 teams in the Championship Race. The boys were lead by senior Blake Harrison with a 17th place finish.
- Our swimmers competed against Mt. View and Flowing Wells on October 5. Both boys and girls won by a large margin. Great job! The varsity football team defeated CDO last Thursday by a score of 21-7. The JV football team defeated Nogales on Wednesday. Our golf teams continue to play well. Cross country had an impressive showing at the Desert Twilight Invitational.
