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### Governing Board Meetings

Governing Board meetings are held the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month (except during school breaks) at 6:30-9:00pm at the Professional Learning Center at Valley View Early Learning Center 3435 E Sunrise Dr. You must forward items for the agenda or Governing Board consideration to the MAC office 8 days prior to the meeting. Field trip and fundraising considerations require an allowance of two (2) board meetings.

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The SY 2016-2017 motto is #honest&kind: focusing on Respect, Honesty, Humility, Kindness, Resilience, Innovation, and Community. This school year promises to be a great year as we set high expectations for learning and for positive character.

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In 2015, the Arizona legislature passed the Arizona Civics Test Law (House Bill 2064). This bill requires students, beginning with the graduating class of 2017, to pass a civics test based on the United States Immigration and Naturalization civics questions. Students will be required to score 60% or higher in order to graduate from high school or obtain a high school equivalency certificate. School districts are required to document on the student's transcript that the student passed the civics test.

Catalina Foothills High School will administer the civics test to juniors and seniors this year, and to Juniors in subsequent years. **The Civics Test administration dates for 2016-2017 are as follows:**

- **Seniors: November 21, 2016**
- **Juniors: February 20, 2017**

The high school will schedule two Fridays each month at 8:30am for retakes and make-up testing. Students who need to retake the test in order to pass, or need to make-up the test due to an absence, will take the test on one of these scheduled dates. CFHS will publish the schedule for retakes and make-up testing.
