

2018 AP EXAMS

2018 Advanced Placement exams will be administered at CFHS from **Monday, May 7- Friday, May 18.**

Students and parents should please read the information in the *Bulletin for AP Students and Parents* and to talk with their AP teacher(s) as they decide whether or not to take AP exams in the spring.

- Students previously approved for testing accommodations should come to the Counseling Office in order to confirm their accommodations with Ms. Petrillo. Students not yet approved for accommodations should see their case manager or Ms. Petrillo as soon as possible to start the accommodation request process. **Requests should be submitted no later than February 19** in order to meet the College Board's deadline.
- Students eligible for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program may qualify for a fee reduction. See the CFHS Bursar for more information or to double check your eligibility prior to registration.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Though we had success using the third-party company--Total Registration--in 2017, we will be returning to the registration system used prior to last year.

To register for AP exams-- students may register and pay online through InTouch or in person at the bursar's office. Parents: if you are registering your son/daughter, please make sure that you are registering for the correct exam. Students and parents are always advised to check their receipts upon registering to make sure the correct exams have been ordered.

Refund policy: *Students may cancel their registration prior to the test date and receive a partial refund. Students who cancel a test ON or BEFORE March 29 will be refunded the full test amount MINUS a \$15.00 administrative fee. Students who cancel a test AFTER March 29 will be refunded the full test amount MINUS \$30.00 (\$15.00 administrative fee and \$15.00 College Board unused test fee). Students must see Ms. Petrillo in the Counseling Office to request to cancel a test.*

Note: **AP Research does not have an end-of-course exam, but an exam must be purchased and ordered for each student enrolled in the course who wants their performance task to be scored by the College Board.*

Additional Quick Facts

- Students will be required to participate in one preadministration session prior to testing day in order to complete the (majority of) answer sheet bubbling for each exam they will take this year. *Students enrolled in AP Social Studies classes will receive this in-class*, but all other students must attend a scheduled session. Additional information will be disseminated later in the spring.
- **Report times:** 7:30 am for morning exams, 12:00 pm for afternoon exams. Students testing in the afternoon should be sure to eat lunch prior to the start of the session.
- Students **must report on time** to their assigned testing rooms. Assigned testing rooms will be posted in all AP classrooms. Students who arrive late may be denied entrance to the testing room.
- **Students are responsible** for knowing which materials to bring to each exam—refer to the AP Bulletin or visit the College Board’s website for details.
- Absences accrued due to AP exams will be verified as a **school-sponsored activity** and will not count against the absence total for the semester. NOTE: Students will be excused only for the window of time they tested, not the entire day.
