Excerpts from Cultivating Curiosity in K-12 Classrooms

Let Students Self-Assess

“One powerful way of providing autonomy to your students is to let them choose how to demonstrate mastery of a concept. You can structure in ways for students to assess their own learning progress by using charts or keeping journals, so they can evaluate how they have changed as they acquire relevant knowledge and skills. As students learn to monitor themselves, they become more motivated by their successes and being to acquire a sense of ownership and responsibility for the role they play in these successes. It’s relatively straightforward to create a format for them to self-monitor their comprehension of the content and reflect upon their process of learning.” (Wendy L. Ostroff, ASCD p 39)
