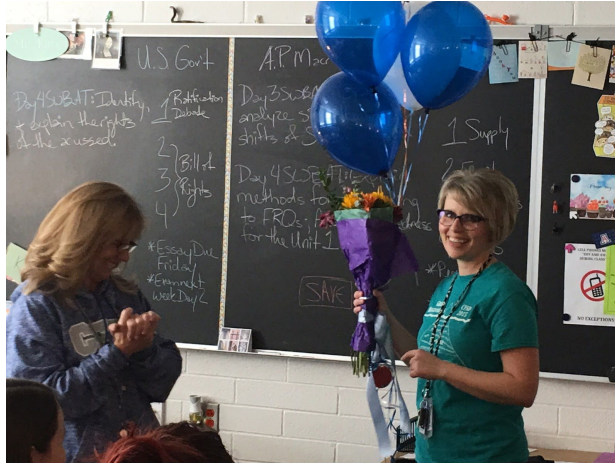
From a community member to the CFHS staff:

Pay for the STAMP 4S test or re-takes in the Bursar's Office or use CFHS' InTouch online payment system. Students who have registered for the STAMP 4S will be contacted with more details.
