Summer School Information & Expectations:

- Students may participate in CFHS summer school for grade replacement or credit recovery if they have received a grade of a D or F in an English, Math, Science, or Social Studies class.
- Students work independently to complete computer-based coursework in a classroom supervised by a certified teacher.
- Students are expected to attend 8:30-3:00 each day until they have completed their course(s). If a student is going to be absent or needs to leave early, a parent/guardian will need to contact the summer program administrator after May 31. Contact information will be provided after enrollment.
- Students may be dropped off or drive themselves. There is no fee for summer parking.
- A 30-minute lunch break and a short afternoon break will be provided. Students need to bring their own food and snacks each day, as there is no meal service on campus.
- Students are expected to abide by the [CFHS Student Handbook](#) during any summer programs or activities. Students may be removed from the program on a temporary or permanent basis due to lack of work completion or for disciplinary issues.
