Tuesday (Oct. 17) kicks off the fall testing season with the 9th grade **CWRA+** (College and Work Readiness Assessment). The CWRA+ will be administered through 9th grade English classes and will take place on Tuesdays-Fridays through November 3. You are able to see the testing schedule on the school calendar, as well as in the Flash each week.

The week after Veteran's Day (week of November 13) we will conduct fall **AzMERIT testing**. The only students who will test are those in credit recovery for one of the AzMERIT courses. Students will be notified if they need to test. Please know that although we try to minimize it as much as possible, students may be late to or absent from some classes due to testing running more than one class period.
