

2019 AP EXAMS

2019 Advanced Placement exams will be administered at CFHS from **Monday, May 6- Friday, May 17.**

Students and parents should please read the information in the *Bulletin for AP Students and Parents* and to talk with their AP teacher(s) as they decide whether or not to take AP exams this spring.

- Students previously approved for testing accommodations should come to the Counseling Office in order to confirm their accommodations with Ms. Petrillo. Students not yet approved for accommodations should see their case manager or Ms. Petrillo as soon as possible to start the accommodation request process. **Requests should be submitted no later than February 15** in order to meet the College Board's deadline.
- Students eligible for the National School Lunch Program may qualify for a fee reduction. See the CFHS Bursar for more information or to double check your eligibility prior to registration.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

To register for AP exams-- students may register and pay **online through InTouch or in person at the bursar's office.** Parents: if you are registering your son/daughter, please make sure that you are registering for the correct exam. Students and parents are always advised to check their receipts upon registering to make sure the correct exams have been ordered.

ADDITIONAL QUICK FACTS

- Students will be required to participate in one preadministration session prior to testing day in order to complete the (majority of) answer sheet bubbling for each exam they will take this year.
 - **Students enrolled in AP Social Studies classes will complete this during class**, but all other students must attend a scheduled session. Additional information will be posted in April.
- **Report times:** 7:30 am for morning exams, 12:00 pm for afternoon exams. Students testing in the afternoon should be sure to eat lunch prior to the start of the session and **should arrange alternate modes of transportation**, as buses will likely have departed by the time exams end.
- Students **must report on time** to their assigned testing rooms. Assigned testing rooms will be posted in all AP classrooms in late April. Students who arrive late may be denied entrance to the testing room.
- **Students are responsible** for knowing which materials to bring to each exam—refer to the Bulletin or visit the College Board’s website for details.
- Any absence accrued due to AP exams will be verified as a **school activity** and will not count against the absence total for the semester. Students will be excused only for the test window, not the entire day.
