Parking and Seating Information for Graduation

<u>Parking:</u> Parking will be available on campus and in the parking lot of St. Thomas the Apostle Catholic Church on Valley View Road. The church is located immediately to the south of the high school. A shuttle service will be provided to bring families to and from the campus for the ceremony. Campus parking will be limited so we ask that our families please carpool if at all possible.

There will be limited mobility parking for family members who need assistance. Limited mobility parking passes will be available on May 6th - please email jmiller@cfsd16.org to reserve a spot and the pass will be in House 1. Please note that parking is prohibited on Pontatoc Road and Valley View Road and will be strictly enforced by the Pima County Sheriff's Department.

Seating for people with limited mobility: Chairs will be available at field level on both sides of the stadium. We ask that only one family member remain with the limited mobility guest and remaining family members sit in the bleachers. Guests who are unable to use stairs may be dropped off at the southeast gate entering the stadium. Carts will be available for any guests who need assistance getting to the stadium.

CFHS Summer School for Credit Recovery ~ 2022

Dates: June 1 through July 1 (Monday-Friday)

Time: 8:30 am – 3:00 pm **Place**: CFHS House 1

Cost: Free

Food: Lunch is provided free of charge

Summer School Information & Expectations:

- Students may participate in CFHS summer school for grade replacement/credit recovery if they have received a
 grade of a D or F in an English, Math, Science, or Social Studies class.
- Students work independently to complete computer-based coursework in a classroom supervised by a certified teacher.
- Students are expected to attend 8:30-3:00 each day until they have completed their course(s). If a student is going to be absent or needs to leave early, a parent or guardian will need to contact the summer program administrator after June 1.
- Students may be dropped off or drive themselves. There is no fee for summer parking.
- A 30-minute lunch break and a short afternoon break will be provided.
- Students are expected to abide by the <u>CFHS Student Handbook</u> during any summer programs or activities.
 Students may be removed from the program on a temporary or permanent basis due to lack of work completion or for behavior issues.




