To: Parents of CFSD Students From: Mary Kamerzell, Superintendent Re: CFSD Open Enrollment Program for the 2023-2024 School Year

The Catalina Foothills School District (CFSD) will begin its open enrollment application procedures for the 2023-2024 school year on **November 1, 2022**.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §15-816 and A.R.S. §15-816.01 all Arizona school districts follow a prescribed procedure and timetable for admitting out-of-district transfer students and resident transfer students (those who live in the District but are attending a school outside the attendance area of their residence). All students who currently attend CFSD schools and reside in other districts, and all CFSD resident students who attend a school outside of the attendance area of their residence, are impacted by this law.

We require *all open enrollment students to apply for admission each year*. Therefore, if your child is a resident transfer (open enrollment) student and you want him/her to continue in that capacity, or if your child resides outside of the district, either as a continuing or a new open enrollment student, please complete an open enrollment application online **between November 1, 2022 and January 31, 2023**.

Open enrollment applications and information regarding the application process are on the district Web site, <u>www.cfsd16.org</u> (as of November 1, 2022). Under Parents, select Open Enrollment.

Electronic applications must be submitted **no later than January 31, 2023**. Decisions about admission, based on capacity, will be made by March 1, 2023. At that time, all applicants who applied during the application period will be notified by email whether their applications were accepted, waitlisted, or declined. *Note: A separate application must be completed for each student*.

Please keep in mind that annually, the open enrollment process involves three steps for all students who reside outside of the attendance boundary of the school that they wish to attend: application, notification of our decision and, if accepted, online registration.

State & District Testing at CFHS in 2022-2023

The Catalina Foothills School District (CFSD) is Tucson's leading educational choice for PreK-12. Academic achievement is a high priority as evidenced by test scores that exceed state and national averages. The Arizona Department of Education (ADE) recognized CFSD as one of the top performing school districts in the state of Arizona, and Niche recognized CFSD with the highest ranking for a unified school district in Arizona from 2015-2022.

The district uses a variety of assessments to measure student achievement and inform instruction. Statewide achievement tests, required by federal and state law, are part of a larger local and state assessment system.

For any senior interested in applying to Pima Community College (PCC), CFHS counselors will be offering a PCC application lab on **Monday January 30th** at 2:30-4 in House 1- Room 110. A PCC admissions representative will be available for questions and application assistance. Laptops will be available.

PCC offers certifications, certificates, two-year degrees, and transfer options. Students must have a high school diploma for admissions, and GPA is not taken into consideration for admission. Scholarships and Honors courses are available.

Families with children entering Kindergarten through Fifth Grade* are invited to enroll their children in Catalina Foothills School District's Mandarin Immersion Program at Sunrise Drive Elementary School for the 2023-2024 school year.

Goals for Students:

- Meet or exceed academic achievement levels in all areas of the district's curriculum as aligned to state standards.
 - Acquire communicative and academic proficiency in English and Chinese.
- Gain an appreciation of other cultures and a deeper understanding of their own culture.
 Increase capacity for creative thinking and problem-solving skills.

In our half-day kindergarten program, 100% of core instruction (Language Arts, Math, Science, Health, and Social Studies) is taught in Chinese. In Grades 1 and above, Language Arts and Social Studies are taught in English, while Science and Health are taught in

Chinese. Math is taught in English. The program is designed

for English-proficient students to acquire Chinese.

Chinese literacy is developed at all grade levels in our immersion program.

Open Enrollment applications should be submitted by January 31, 2023. *Students in grades 2-5 must meet language proficiency criteria for enrollment.
