ACT Practice Test for Grades 10-11

Sunday, February 4, 2024

8:30 am – 1:00 pm at CFHS Cafeteria

- This practice ACT allows students to experience a full-length ACT test and identify strengths as well as areas for additional review without the pressure of sending scores to colleges. Note: There are no extended time accommodations for this practice test.
- Note: All Juniors will be taking the official ACT at CFHS on April 3 as a state-mandated school assessment. This practice test opportunity will support students who want to do especially well on the April ACT if applying to colleges that might consider ACT/SAT test scores in their admissions processes. Free ACT preparation/practice is available at act.org/academy.
- Note: Most colleges are now test-optional or test-free but students who plan to take an official ACT and/or SAT for college admissions are encouraged to do so in the spring of their junior year. Go to bit.ly/ACTSATInfo for more information about the ACT and SAT college admissions tests.
- A detailed score report will be emailed to students (or available for pick up from the counseling office) approximately 3 weeks from the test date.
