On November 20th, we marked a significant milestone in the construction of the Fine Arts building by holding a beam signing ceremony. The event was hosted by Core Construction, Swain Architects, and CFHS and attended by members of the CFSD Governing Board, the Administration, Facilities personnel, orchestra and guitar students, and local media representatives. Note: **No early exams are given**. Students who miss a final exam will be given a zero for the missed exam. If there are compelling reasons why the student missed the exams and the scheduled make-up period, they may take a make-up exam within the first 10 days of the second semester. The final grade will then be recalculated with the final exam score replacing the zero. **Any questions should be directed to the teacher and the grade level administrator.**

To maintain a positive and fair testing environment for students, we expect all student to remain in the classroom for the entire exam period. The front office will not call into a classroom or interrupt the testing to dismiss any students from class prior to the bell. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in ensuring that all our students are able to complete their exams.

To: Parents of CFSD Students From: Mary Kamerzell, Superintendent Re: CFSD Open Enrollment Program for the 2024-2025 School Year

The Catalina Foothills School District (CFSD) will begin its open enrollment application procedures for the 2024-2025 school year on **November 1, 2023**.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §15-816 and A.R.S. §15-816.01 all Arizona school districts follow a prescribed procedure and timetable for admitting out-of-district transfer students and resident transfer students (those who live in the District but are attending a school outside the attendance area of their residence). All students who currently attend CFSD schools and reside in other districts, and all CFSD resident students who attend a school outside of the attendance area of their residence, are impacted by this law.

We require *all open enrollment students to apply for admission each year*. Therefore, if your child is a resident transfer (open enrollment) student and you want them to continue in that capacity, or if your child resides outside of the district, either as a continuing or a new open enrollment student, please complete an open enrollment application online **between November 1, 2023, and January 31, 2024**.

Open enrollment applications and information regarding the application process are on the district Web site, <u>www.cfsd16.org</u> (as of November 1, 2023). Under Parents, select Open Enrollment.

Electronic applications must be submitted **no later than January 31, 2024**. Decisions about admission, based on capacity, will be made by March 1, 2024. At that time, all applicants who applied during the application period will be notified by email whether their applications were accepted, waitlisted, or declined. *Note: A separate application must be completed for each student*.

Please keep in mind that annually, the open enrollment process involves three steps for all students who reside outside of the attendance boundary of the school that they wish to attend: application, notification of our decision and, if accepted, online registration.

Is your student interested in enrolling in an off-site Pima JTED course for the 2024-25 school year? Pre-enrollment starts on January 29, 2024, at 3:00pm and some programs fill up quickly. CFHS counselors will be holding a **Pima JTED Application Lab on Monday, January 29th** in the House 1 Seminar Room from 3-4pm, to assist with questions and help students fill out and submit the pre-enrollment form. Laptops will be available.

- Students are encouraged to go onto the Pima JTED website to take the Career Quiz, to determine which programs might be a good match, and then review the information for each program of their interest prior to January 29.
- Note: CFHS offers ten CTE/JTED courses/pathways on campus, which students simply choose during course selection. The Pima JTED courses offered off-site after school are separate and students must go through the pre-enrollment process via the pimajted.org website to be enrolled.

State & District Testing at CFHS in 2023-2024

The Catalina Foothills School District (CFSD) is Tucson's leading educational choice for PreK-12. Academic achievement is a high priority as evidenced by test scores that exceed state and national averages. The Arizona Department of Education (ADE) recognized CFSD as one of the top performing school districts in the state of Arizona, and Niche recognized CFSD with the highest ranking for a unified school district in Arizona from 2015-2022.

The district uses a variety of assessments to measure student achievement and inform instruction. Statewide achievement tests, required by federal and state law, are part of a larger local and state assessment system.





Families with children entering Kindergarten through Fifth Grade* are invited to enroll their children in Catalina Foothills School District's Mandarin Immersion Program at Sunrise Drive Elementary School for the 2024-2025 school year.

Goals for Students:

• Meet or exceed academic achievement levels in all areas of the district's curriculum as aligned to state standards.

• Acquire communicative and academic proficiency in English and Chinese.

• Gain an appreciation of other cultures and a deeper understanding of their own culture. • Increase capacity for creative thinking and problem-solving skills.

In our half-day kindergarten program, 100% of core instruction (Language Arts, Math, Science, Health, and Social Studies) is taught in Chinese. In Grades 1 and above, Language Arts, Math, and Social Studies are taught in English, while Science and Health are taught in Chinese. Chinese literacy is developed at all grade levels in our immersion program.
