Summer School Information & Expectations:

- Students may participate in CFHS summer school for grade replacement/credit recovery if they have received a grade of a D or F in English, Math, Science, or Social Studies.
- Students work independently to complete computer-based coursework in a classroom supervised by a certified teacher.
- Students are expected to attend 8:30-3:00 each day until they have completed their course(s). If a student is going to be absent or needs to leave early, a parent/guardian will need to contact the summer program administrator after June 1.
- Students may be dropped off or drive themselves. There is no fee for summer parking.
- A 30-minute lunch break and a short afternoon break will be provided.
- Students are expected to abide by the <u>CFHS Student Handbook</u> during any summer programs or activities. Students may be removed from the program on a temporary or permanent basis due to lack of work completion or for behavior issues.
