Parking and Seating Information for Graduation

<u>Parking:</u> Parking will be available on campus and in the parking lot of St. Thomas the Apostle Catholic Church on Valley View Road. The church is located immediately to the south of the high school. A shuttle service will be provided to bring families to and from the campus for the ceremony. Campus parking will be limited so we ask that our families please carpool if at all possible.

There will be limited mobility parking for family members who need assistance. Limited mobility parking passes will be available on May 6th. Please note that parking is prohibited on Pontatoc Road and Valley View Road and will be strictly enforced by the Pima County Sheriff's Department.

<u>Seating for people with limited mobility:</u> Chairs will be available at field level on both sides of the stadium. We ask that only one family member remain with the limited mobility guest and remaining family members sit in the bleachers. Guests who are unable to use stairs may be dropped off at the southeast gate entering the stadium. Carts will be available for any guests who need assistance getting to the stadium.

Free Summer School for Credit Recovery

Students who received an F during the school year in English, Math, Science, or Social Studies, or who wish to replace a D, are eligible to retake the course in our free summer school program. CFHS Summer School is self-paced/computer-based and classrooms are supervised by a certified teacher. Students attend in person 8:30-3:00 (with breaks) starting June 1 and continue daily until the coursework is completed. End date is July 1. Information Regarding 2022 AP Exams

- Exam registration is now closed. Students who have not yet made payment will be contacted personally. Exams will take place during the first two weeks of May. Refer to College Board's website for test dates.
- Students should have a **personal email address** linked to their MyAP accounts, as College Board will be sending important updates and reminders.
- **AP Score Report:** Starting April 11, students will see a pop-up window prompting them to choose a college, university, or scholarship organization to receive their AP scores for free.
- The 2022 **AP Exam Terms and Conditions** are now available to review at cb.org/apexamterms. Students will need to accept these terms and conditions prior to taking each exam.
- Report time for morning exams is 7:45. All exams should be completed in time for students to attend lunch, however students may consider bringing lunch on mornings they are testing.
- Report time for afternoon exams is 12:00 pm. Students testing in the afternoon should plan for transportation home from school, as they may miss the bus. Students testing in the afternoon should also attend first lunch on the day of the exam.
- Classroom assignments and other details will be emailed to students later this spring.

NOTE FROM THE NURSE

April, 2022

Spring has Sprung and Allergies are in Season!

Please note that we do not have allergy medicine in the Health Office. If your son/daughter has allergy issues, please consider consulting your Health Care Provider about medicating your son/daughter before school or providing allergy medications for the Health Office. If needed at school, the medication must be in the original container and the At-School Medication Consent form has to be **signed by a parent and cosigned by a medical provider.**

Illness Reminders:

Please note that students need to be home and on medication for 24 hours, before returning to school it they have PINK EYE or STREP THROAT, as they are considered highly contagious.

Students need to be fever-free without fever-reducing medication (Ibuprofen or Acetaminophen) for 24 hours before returning to school.

Injuries/Concussions/Mobility Issues:

Please contact the School Nurse with any documentation of injuries, so that we can alert teachers, and set appropriate measures in place for the student (restrictions, elevator key, etc.)

End-of-year reminders:

- 1) If your son/daughter no longer needs the **elevator key**, please remind them to return it to the BURSAR to get their refund.
- 2) If your son/daughter has medications in school that they may not need, or have left over from field trips, please contact the Health Office at 520-209-8330 and make arrangements for pick-up of the medications, preferably before the last day of school, or they will be discarded on Wednesday, May 25th.
- 3) Encourage students to HYDRATE with the warmer weather and to use sunscreen.
- 4) Print, Complete, sign and submit HEALTH INFORMATION AND EMERGENCY CONTACT FORMS for next school year 2022-23 ASAP. See link below:


