
Club Fair, tours and course information will be provided for new students (incoming grades 9-12) interested in attending CFHS.

MATH AND LANGUAGE ASSESSMENTS

Math Placement Assessments:

Entering 9th graders who have already completed Algebra 1 will be placed in Geometry. Those wishing to take Honors Geometry or higher-level Honors math courses will be able to take a math assessment during New-to-CFSD Freshman Registration on Saturday, April 26 (If registering after April 26, go to bit.ly/CFHSMath to register for the May 28 or July 30 placement assessment).

Entering 10-12th graders who wish to take Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra 2, or APrecalculus need to take a math placement assessment on either Wednesday, May 28, at 10:00 am, or Wednesday, July 30, at 12:00 noon. Students must sign up for this assessment at **bit.ly/CFHSMath**

Spanish/Chinese Placement Assessments:

All freshmen and all new-to-CFHS 10-12 grade students who have not completed two years of the same World Language at the high school level, will need to take a placement assessment as part of the registration process.
