#### School and Community

Catalina Foothills High School is located in the shadow of the Santa Catalina Mountains on Tucson's north side. Most district families are headed by college-educated professionals who value education, expect excellence, and provide a great deal of support to their students and to the school. The district has the highest teacher salaries in greater Tucson and over 60% of CFHS faculty and administration hold advanced degrees. This public high school, operating on a semester system, has a student population of approximately 1900 students in grades 9 through 12. Approximately 50% of students live out-of-district. 11% qualify for free/reduced lunch. 12% identified a language other than English as their first language.


